

How to care for embroidery threads?

Product storage

- Store your embroidery threads in a place that is protected from permanent exposure to: light (both natural or artificial), heaters and humidity.

Recommendations for washing embroidered fabric and clothing:

- Only handwashing is recommended.
- Use soap or detergent for delicate fabrics. Chemical products such as whitening components or very strong detergents may discolor the embroidery.
- Don't leave clothes soaking for more than 30 minutes, this will not improve the results of your washing and may damage the embroidery.
- Do not use a scrubbing brush on the embroidered fabric.
- Always rinse with plenty of cold water.
- Don't wring out fabric by twisting it, this can damage your clothing.
- Don't hang the wet fabric, take out the excess water with a towel.
- You may use a drying machine with low temperature, if the fabric allows it.
- Dry clean only when the manufacturer's instructions say so, some materials should not be dry cleaned.

Recommendations for ironing embroidered fabric and clothing:

- Iron with low temperature, if the fabric allows it. This information can be found on the manufacturing label of each product.
- Always iron clothes inside out.
- Only use steam ironing for the materials indicated on the iron.
