

How should I care for my knitting yarn?

Product storage

- Store your knitting yarns in a place that is protected from permanent exposure to: light (both natural or artificial), heaters and humidity.

Recommendations for washing knit products:

- Only handwash with cold water.
- Use soap or detergent for delicate fabrics. Chemical products such as whitening components or very strong detergents may discolor the yarn.
- Don't leave knit products soaking for more than 30 minutes, this will not improve the results of your washing and may damage the knitting.
- Do not use a scrubbing brush on the knitting.
- Always rinse with plenty of cold water.
- Don't wring out the product by twisting it, this can damage your knitting.
- Don't hang the wet product, lay it out horizontally on a towel and let it air dry.
- Don't let your damp knit clothing be in contact with other textiles, this can contaminate the yarn.
- Do not use a drying machine.
- You can dry clean the product.

Recommendations for ironing knit products:

- Do not use the iron to dry the knitting, high temperatures may damage it.
- If you use an iron, it must be with low temperature.
- Always iron the knit products inside out, using a thin cotton fabric between the iron and the knit fabric.
